



Needs analysis Need of the target group

The Teach with Erasmus+ project identified that academic staff of a European HEI has several obstacles when participating in a teaching or training mobility programme. These obstacles:

- academic staff
- Lacks proper quality assurance
- Less accessible for junior staff

Offer solutions to the difficulties of teaching mobility

- create a site (Marketplace, Hub, etc.) where teaching staff can meet and exchange (using available technologies)
- find/offer opportunities for teaching or training mobility
- facilitate, encourage, and promote teachers' mobility (TM) across Europe
- Invite those who offer their expertise on the site and/or apply for a training/mobility advertised for teachers on the site
